I am a member testing in my home region.

- Go to kp.org or call your home region's appointment line to schedule a pre-travel COVID-19 test.
- To view test results, login to your kp.org account.
 - For minors 11 years of age and under, link your child's account to your account.
 - For minors 12–17, check with your home region on how teen can view COVID test result. Testing at an outside facility may be recommended to ensure the ability to view test results. (See trusted travel partner list at <https://hawaiiicovid19.com/travel/> .)

I am a member testing in a Kaiser Permanente facility outside my home region.

- Call the Away-from-Home Travel Line at **951-268-3900*** Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Pacific time to set up visiting member account and visiting member kp.org account.
- For minors ages 17 and under: Testing at an outside facility is recommended. (See trusted travel partner list at <https://hawaiiicovid19.com/travel/> .)

I am a member testing outside of a Kaiser Permanente facility.

- Locate trusted testing partner facilities at <https://hawaiiicovid19.com/travel/>.
- State of Hawaii requires Nucleic Acid Amplification Test (NAAT).
- Contact the testing partner directly to schedule a test and learn how results can be viewed.



Complete pre-travel questionnaire (available 24-hours before flight) at travel.hawaii.gov and upload test results when available.
